Executive Summary:

This FDP was planned primarily keeping our Research Scholars in mind. But the scholars from other universities and institutes, along with our faculty members, also constituted our target audience. The FDP had various sessions, including modules on understanding Qualitative Research (with a focus on Ethnographic and Grounded Theory), Quantitative Research (with hands-on sessions SPSS) and intricacies of Academic Writing. 


